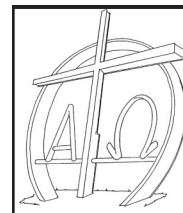

## Fred Booth

Fred Booth taught school and coached for 37 years. He was a junior high coach for three years, a freshman and junior varsity coach for nine years, and a varsity coach for 24 years. Booth lead the 1982 boys' track team to a state title.

In 24 seasons as a head basketball coach, his teams averaged 17 wins a year. Mr. Booth's teams won ten regional titles, thirteen conference titles and had ten sectional appearances. Winning the state title in 2001 resulted in Coach Booth being selected as the Wisconsin Boys Basketball Coach of the Year by WBCA. 84% of the boys who played for Booth as seniors graduated from college and in 37 years Mr. Booth never received a technical foul.

In 1993, Booth was selected as an Eau Claire area teacher of the Year. Mr. Booth has organized over 50 basketball tournaments, coached at over 100 basketball camps, organized numerous AAU teams and organized trips to Arizona and Colorado for different AAU basketball teams.

Mr. Booth coached in the World Tournament in 1993 and 2005. Three of his teams had perfect regular seasons in 1989, 1998 and 2006. Coach Booth was honored as the National Basketball Coaches Association National Boys Basketball Coach of the Year in 2006 for his leadership and dedication to young people. Many former players are now successful coaches in their own right.

Coach Booth brings a theme to the game of basketball that emphasizes the teaching of skill and having fun while playing the game. Coach Booth carries a strong faith in the Lord, an integral part of this basketball camp.

For the last five years, Mr. Tiberg has worked with the Northland College Men's Basketball program as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. During this time he has also taught physical education, served as athletic director and coached 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade basketball at St. Louis Catholic School in Washburn, WI. He continues to serve students in Ashland, WI working with students in various areas; working towards knowledge, skills and work ethic.
